



A comprehensive guide to the Contain-A-Lock® Padlock Protector Shroud - installation and removal of the padlock.

PADLOCK INSTALLATION:

STEP 1: Preparing the Padlock and Carriage

- 1. Hold the carriage so that its hook is facing upward.
- 2. Insert the unlocked padlock into the carriage.







STEP 2: Inserting the Carriage into the Shroud

- 1. Open the container door that has the welded shroud (the lock box).
- 2. You will need to insert the carriage into the shroud so that it can hang from the horizontal rail inside.
- 3. To do it correctly, hold the carriage with the padlock facing you.



Horizontal rail: Keeps your padlock secure in the shroud when doors are open.

Metal lip

- 4. Insert the carriage into the shroud and slide it to the right.
- 5. Ensure the metal lip is positioned inside the inner U-bend of the padlock.





- 6. With the padlock in place, lift it fully, then slide to the left until the hook catches the rail.
- 7. Test by sliding the padlock side-to-side. If it moves freely, it's correctly installed.









STEP 3: Locking the Container Door

- 1. With the padlock hanging from the rail, close the container door.
- 2. From underneath, slide the padlock toward the staple.
- 3. Push the locking pin through the staple and lock the padlock.



Staple: A small, U-shaped metal fitting attached to a container door, designed for a padlock to pass through in order to secure and lock the container.



PADLOCK REMOVAL:

STEP 1: Opening the Container Door

While the Contain-A-Lock® Padlock Protector Shroud is designed to keep the padlock on the rail when the container doors are open, the steps below show how to remove it if needed.

- 1. Unlock the padlock and pull down the locking pin.
- 2. While facing the front of the shroud, slide the padlock to the right, away from the staple.
- 3. Open the container door with the shroud welded onto it.

STEP 2: Removing the Padlock

- 1. Now, facing the back of the shroud, slide the padlock to the right toward the metal lip until you feel the hook release from the rail.
- 2. Pull the padlock down until the top of its inner U-bend is stopped by the metal lip.
- 3. Move the padlock slightly up and to the left, and you should now be able to pull it down freely.
